

# Marriage Licenses

## Requirements

Each person applying for a license must:

- \* Appear together at the County Clerk's Office
- \* Provide a VALID and CURRENT State or Government issued picture identification for proof of identity and age (such as a Driver's License, Texas Identification Card or a Passport)
- \* We do not accept the Matricula Consular Card
- \* Provide Social Security Number (if applicable)
- \* Not have been divorced within the last 30 days (or provide a waiver)
- \* Not be presently married to someone other than the other applicant
- \* Not be related to the other applicant
- \* Be 18 years or older to obtain a marriage license (as of 09-01-2017)

## Time Periods

From the date and time the marriage license is issued by the County Clerk:

- \* The parties must wait 72 hours before using the marriage license
- \* The license cannot be used on or after the 91st day, as it expires on the 90th day after being issued.
- \* The 72-hour waiting period may be waived if one applicant is a member of the Armed Forces of the United States and on active duty.
- \* The 72-hour waiting period may be waived if both applicants complete the "Twogether-in-Texas" marriage education class.

## Fees

### Marriage License Fees

Copies of marriages licenses (originally purchased in Parker County)	\$8
Informal Marriage-CASH or CREDIT	\$46
With a "Twogether-in-Texas" class certificate-CASH or CREDIT	\$21
Without a "Twogether-in-Texas" class certificate-CASH or CREDIT	\$81

## Marriage Education Classes

As of September 1, 2008, couples who complete the "Twogether-in-Texas" marriage education class will not be charged the \$60 state portion of their marriage license fee. ONLY "Twogether-In-Texas" marriage education certificate will be acceptable. All other marriage education certificates are not eligible for \$60 discount.
